**General information in connection with the shipping of
vehicles by sea**

Below are the minimum requirements for vehicles used for shipment at sea:

- Any vehicle that is to be shipped on board a ferry has to have appropriate lashing points to be secured seaworthy on deck. A shipment without sufficient number of lashing points is in the responsibility of each load master or captain.
- As a rule of thumb is one lashing point per 10 tons. total weight evenly distributed, per side of the vehicle. This means at e.g. a standard artic truck, there should be ideally 4 lashing rings on each side of the vehicle (trailer and tractor).
- The company reserves the right at any time and without notice to change the timetable, the vessel or loading equipment. This affects also already confirmed reservations.
- Generally, always the master of the ship has got the last decision, whether a vehicle intended for shipment is admitted or not. Furthermore, the master of the ship has the right to reject the shipment of any vehicle without adequate lashing points because of bad weather.
